
Additionally, feedback was collected from the school heads, who welcomed the initiative and acknowledged the importance of career counselling in helping students make informed academic choices.


Concluding Remarks:


Concluding Remarks:


With growing interest in BBA, BCA, and BSc, we aim to continue guiding students toward quality education and career opportunities.




