



Action taken for Admission process (session 2025-26)

1. Pre-Admission Counselling Programme.

A pre-admission counselling programme was organized from 21st to 25th February, 2025 for students of local schools near the college.

2. Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

Academic and Infrastructure Developments

Approval by HPU for new courses

1. Approval was granted by Himachal Pradesh University (HPU) on 19th June, 2025 for starting B.C.A. and B.B.A. (Self-Financing) courses with an intake of 60 seats each, along with approval for 5 Post-Graduate courses. The classes for the B.C.A. Regular classes started on 10th July, 2025, and all 60 seats were filled.

2. Introduction of B.Sc. Courses and Sanction of Permanent Posts

B.Sc. courses have been started, and **permanent posts** have been sanctioned in **five subjects**:

Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, and Mathematics.

3. N.C.C. Unit Approval

Approval for starting an **N.C.C. Unit** in the college was granted vide letter dated **30th September, 2025**. (27 cadets enrolled)

Infrastructure and Facilities

- Three Smart Classrooms are fully functional in the college.
- Library furniture has been purchased for the students' reading section, including 20 Chairs and 6 reading tables.
- Physics Laboratory has been established; laboratories for other subjects are under process.
- Computer Laboratory has been established.
- College campus proposal for steel structures and iron benches for the waiting area has been submitted.
- Proposal for furniture for the college canteen has been submitted.
- Proposal for staff appointment for P.G. classes and laboratory staff is under consideration.
- Proposal for Physical Education Teacher and IT Teacher has been submitted.
- Creation of additional posts proposed for Sanskrit, Music (Vocal & Instrumental), and Geography.
- The college is in the process of shifting to a new building.
- The book demand proposals have been prepared and sent in accordance with the specific requirements of the college, and the processing of these proposals is currently underway.

Hostel and Major Projects

- Foundation stone of Girls' Hostel laid on 28th July, 2024 under GIA Component – PM-USHA.
- Proposal for Boys'(SC category) Hostel submitted under PM-AJAY Scheme on dated 12-Aug-2025.
- 330 fully furnished benches provided for students in the Examination Hall.
- Three lecture theatres, each with a seating capacity for 90 students, have been established to provide adequate learning space..

this year. however the same may
may form a day or two due to
some official constraint in the university.
However, the preparation were
required to be up-to-speed without

any future delay.
